The degree brought together aspects of computer science, machine learning, AI, mathematics and data management in a cohesive program designed to prepare students with advanced technical, computational, and quantitative skills to develop data driven solutions to important problems. We believe that the new name of the degree better reflects the technical and computational skills in data sciences that we teach, and is more widely recognized in industry.
